Jon Beggs opened the zoom meeting at 1:02 PM with devotion and prayer.

Minutes of May 11, 2021 meeting were **APPROVED** as presented.

Communications – none.

Polly gave a brief Executive Presbyter and Stated Clerk report.

• Now traveling again which includes attending worship services at PCN churches. Will be attending board meeting of Omaha Presbyterian Seminary Foundation later this month and plans to attend AMCL continuing education event in Baltimore, MD at the beginning of October. Presbytery Pastors' Lunch group will resume on September 23.

Personnel Committee – Eddie reported that the committee met on September 7. They recommend the following:

- The Executive Presbyter and Stated Clerk (Polly) receive a 2% cost of living raise for 2022.
- The Administrative Assistant's (Judy R.) hourly salary be increased from \$22/hour to \$23/hour for 2022.
- The Recording Clerk's (Judy H.) salary be increased from \$125/Presbytery meeting to \$150/Presbytery meeting.
- Council **APPROVED** each recommendation.

Business and Budget Committee – Don reported that the committee met on September 7. They recommend the following:

- Approve overspending Line item# 5430p (COM Resources & Training) in the amount of \$760.00. Budget was \$500.00. Council **APPROVED**.
- Requested that B & B Committee be authorized, by majority vote, to approve expenditures more than budgeted line items and be authorized to approve withdrawals of principal from investments to pay for Presbytery expenditures. Council APPROVED.
- Requested that on the proposed 2022 budget, consolidate Mission grants, Church Development grants, and Technology grants into a single grant program called Presbytery Grants.
 - Purpose: to assist local congregations to deliver the Word in new ways and/or to new populations.
 - \circ $\;$ Amount: \$25,000 with ability to fund up to 10 individual grants limited to \$2,500 in 2022.
 - Restrictions: not to be used for maintenance, replacement, or updates of existing assets. Grant will not exceed 75% of total cost of the project. Only one grant per congregation per year. If a higher level of internet service (or something similar) is required, one year of the increased cost of present cost may be included in the project. Council **APPROVED**.
- Requested that Council approve the proposed 2022 budget. Motion was APPROVED.

Nominating Committee – Polly reported that no applications to serve as General Assembly Commissioners have been received. Each committee chair has been asked to provide a "job description" for possible recruits. Bob Scriven expressed his concern as an "at large member" of Council that after attending multiple Council and Presbytery meetings he is "still trying to figure out what is going on" and "what his committee responsibilities are". Council will meet on October 12 for the purpose of reviewing and filling committee vacancies.

COM Committee – Joyce reported that the committee met on September 14.

- Linda Lambert's commissioning service will be September 19, 2021, at First Presbyterian Church. She will be serving both Bethany Presbyterian Church and O'Neill.
- Committee recommends that Presbytery of Central Nebraska pastors' salary be increased 3% for 2022.
- Superior and Fullerton have prospective candidates to fill their pulpits.

CPM Committee – Greg reported that annual consults with candidates under Presbytery care will be held on October 8.

Youth Committee – no report.

Presbytery Women – Annabelle was absent, but she submitted a report to remind everyone that the PW Fall Gathering will be held at Westminster United Presbyterian Church, Minden on Saturday, September 18 at 9 AM. Lunch will be served.

Synod Commissioner – Sue reported that all Synod committees are functioning, and finances are good.

Council reviewed the proposed October 23, 2021, Presbytery Docket. Council **APPROVED** that the meeting be held on Zoom. Kirwin will present the report of Council. Polly will arrange for a preacher. Offering will be given to the donors' choice. Docket was **APPROVED**.

Report from CPM:

We have one candidate under care as an "inquirer" in the traditional ordination process: Sarah Babcock is a 2nd year student at Louisville Seminary and is under care of First Presbyterian Church of Hastings.

We have one candidate under care in the Commissioned Ruling Elder/Commissioned Lay Pastor ordination process:

Janet Rasmussen is taking classes through University of Dubuque Theological Seminary.

We held annual consultations with both candidates on October 8, 2021.

We had a third candidate under care, Kailen Soncksen. She sent us a letter in October stating her desire to be removed from the ordination process.

Kailen has been under care of the CPM and the Session of First Presbyterian Church of Hastings for 3 years and is completing her senior year at Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary. She discerned that she is no longer called to ordained ministry in the Presbyterian Church (USA). She stated that she is grateful for the support of the members of CPM who served as her discernment partners in this process.

Leadership transition for the CPM began in January with Greg Allen-Pickett taking over as chair and Jill Boyd being available to guide and assist until she rotates off the committee the end of the year.
